You find licensed electronic media via our homepage "Search & Find" <https://www.hft-stuttgart.com/hft/facilities/bibliothek/suchen-finden> in the library catalogue, in databases via Database Information System DBIS and in the Elektronische Zeitschriftenbibliothek (EZB). In the german language version of "Search & Find" ("Suchen & Finden") are some german language instructions on how to authenticate via Shibboleth to read e-books off-campus and how to use databases. We use many screenshots, so hopefully they will be useful for non-german speakers as well. We are working on english language versions and will upload them as soon as possible.
