Content

How can I show my expertise in an academic setting? How can I raise interest for my research? How do I defend my findings and convince an academic audience? Academic presentations are a key qualification for students and researchers of all fields and at all stages of their academic career. At our first appointment, we will explore the question: What makes a good presentation? We will analyse selected keynote speeches and discuss the right strategy for your presentation. In self-study, you will prepare and practice the introduction for your presentation. At our second appointment, we will explore the question: What makes good presentation slides? You will also practice the introduction to your presentation. In self-study, you will prepare your slides for a 10-minute presentation. At our third appointment, we will explore the question: How can I rock the show? You will hold your presentations and receive constructive feedback on your performance.
