## Statutes on the Charge of Study Fees in the Master Programme Smart City Solutions

Please note: The English version of the Fees Statutes has been created for reference purposes. Only the original German version is legally binding. In this context, Hochschule für Technik Stuttgart cannot assume any liability for damages arising from misinterpretations of the German original in the English version.

Pursuant to § 2 (1), § 13 (1) of the State University Fees Act (Landeshochschulgebührengesetz - LHGebG) of 1 May 2015, last amended on 15 October 2019 (Journal of Laws p. 405, 411), the Senate of Hochschule für Technik Stuttgart (University of Applied Sciences Stuttgart) has adopted the following fee statutes on 11 December 2019:

On 11 December 2019, the Rector has approved the statutes in accordance with § 2 (2) Sentence 2 LHGebG.

### § 1 Obligation to Charge Fees

Hochschule für Technik Stuttgart charges students a study fee for their studies in the non-consecutive Master programme Smart City Solutions. The collection of fees, contributions to administrative costs, expenses and fees in accordance with §§ 1 (2), 12, 16, 18 and 19 LHGebG, as well as contributions in accordance with the Student Union Act (Studentenwerkgesetz) remain unaffected.

### § 2 Amount Payable

- (1) The study fee is charged each semester. In accordance with the Study and Examination Regulations of the Master programme, they apply as follows:

#### 1.1 Full-time study

1st semester	EUR 4,000
2nd semester	EUR 4,000
3rd semester	EUR 2,000

#### 1.2 Part-time study

1st semester	EUR 2,000
2nd semester	EUR 2,000
3rd semester	EUR 2,000
4th semester	EUR 2,000
5th semester	EUR 2,000

For any additional semester, a study fee of EUR 1000 shall be charged.

- (2) Periods of leave of absence from studies are not subject to fees if the application for leave of absence has been submitted before the beginning of the lecture period. If a student only becomes aware of a circumstance that entitles him or her to a leave of absence after the beginning of the lecture period, the fee will be refunded proportionately.

### § 3 Fee Reduction

- (1) Upon application, a reduction of the study fee by EUR 500 (full-time) or EUR 250 (part-time) per semester can be granted to students

1. Who care for and bring up\* a child that has not reached the age of 14 by the beginning of the respective semester. (\*The term "care for and bring up" only covers children who can prove that they live in the domestic flat)

2. Whose disability within the meaning of § 2 of the Ninth Book of the German Social Code (Neuntes Sozialgesetzbuch) has a significant impact on their studies
3. Who are foreign students enrolled under agreements on state, federal or international level or under university agreements that guarantee exemption from taxes.

(2) Upon application, a fee reduction of EUR 1,000 can be granted on the semester fees as specified in § 2 for the 3rd semester in which the Master thesis is to be completed in accordance with the Study and Examination Regulations, if the student simultaneously prepares his/her Master thesis for a degree in a Master programme in Business Administration (MBA) at a university cooperating with the HFT Stuttgart. This also applies if the two universities jointly submit a thesis within the areas of Master of Engineering and Master of Business Administration and these two areas are evaluated separately. Fees and charges imposed by the cooperating university are not part of these statutes.

(3) All applications are to be submitted before the start of the lecture period.

#### **§ 4 Due Dates**

The study fee is due on the payment dates specified in the notice of fees. In the event of a fee reduction in accordance with § 3 (2), the fee for that semester must be paid in one sum. Details are regulated in the notice of fees.

#### **§ 5 Refund**

In the case of exmatriculation within one month of the start of the lecture period, the study fee will be refunded. If the study programme is discontinued at a later point in the semester, the full study fee for the semester has to be paid.

#### **§ 6 Inception**

These fee statutes shall be effective on the day after their public announcement, and will first apply for students starting their studies in the winter semester 2020/21.
